When is childcare available?

Childcare for morning cardio classes is available on Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings from 9:00 and 10:30. Space is limited and registration is required.

How much does it cost? How do I pay?

Childcare for morning cardio class participants is paid for by Immanuel's Recreation Childcare budget. You pay only for the cardio instruction.

Will there be other programs using the Childcare Room?

Yes. We also provide childcare support for two Women's Bible Study Groups. Your child will have the opportunity to make many new friends.

Do you have childcare for evening classes?

No. At this point, the budget simply does not allow for both morning and evening childcare support.



What is recreation childcare?

Preschool-age childcare support is made available by Immanuel for participants of morning cardio classes.



What are the ratios of teacher to child?

Ratios for teachers to infants and crawlers are 1:3. Ratios for teachers to walkers thru pre-K are 1:7 (with 27 being the maximum number of children in the room at one time). Our ratios are well below state standards – we value the safety and quality of care your children receive while in our facility.

What about your teachers?

A condition of employment in Immanuel childcare is passing a criminal check through the State Police Department and a background check through the Cabinet for Health and Family Services. All staff members are experienced with children and some are working on or have already completed degrees in childhood education areas.
